

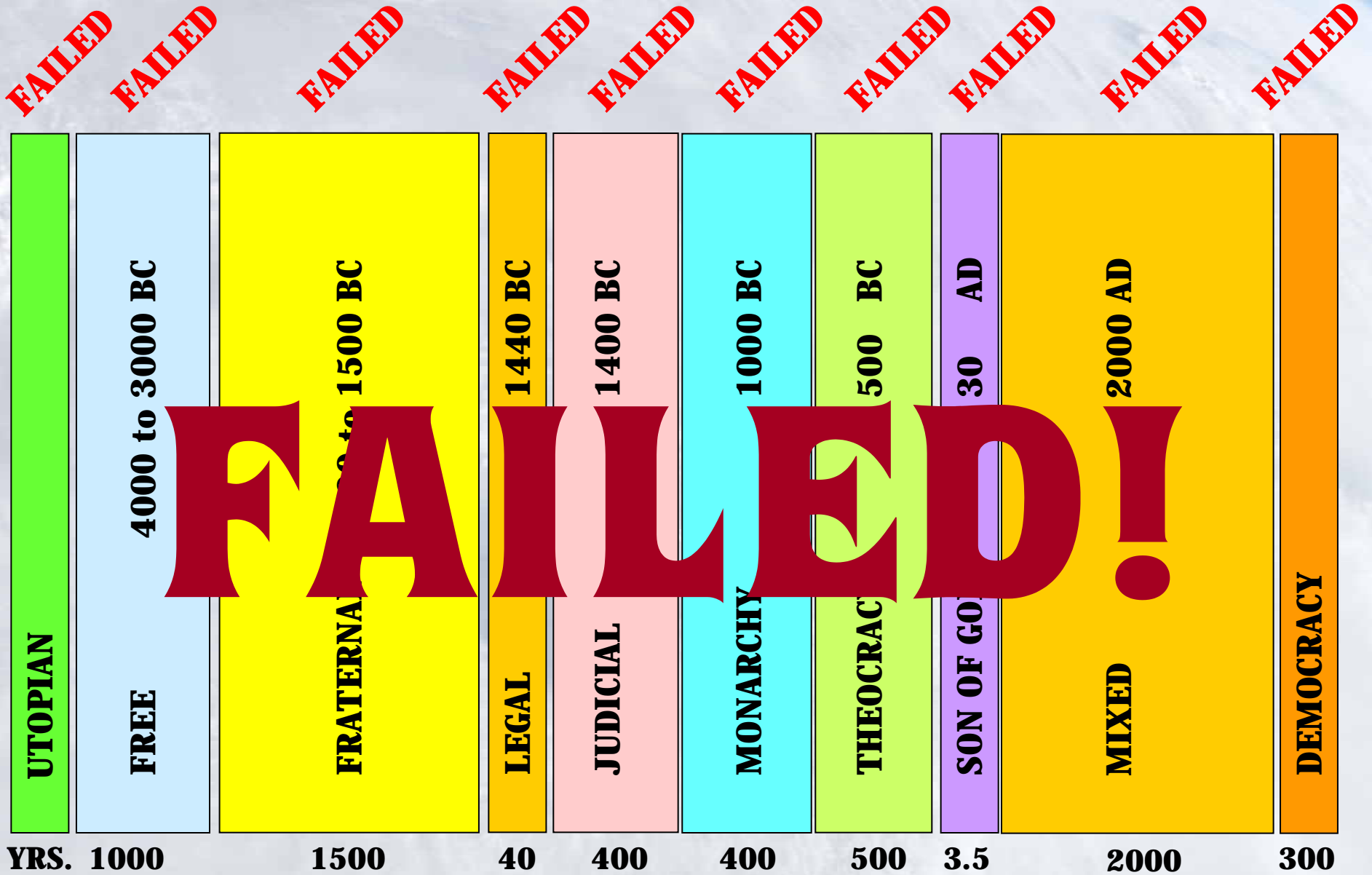

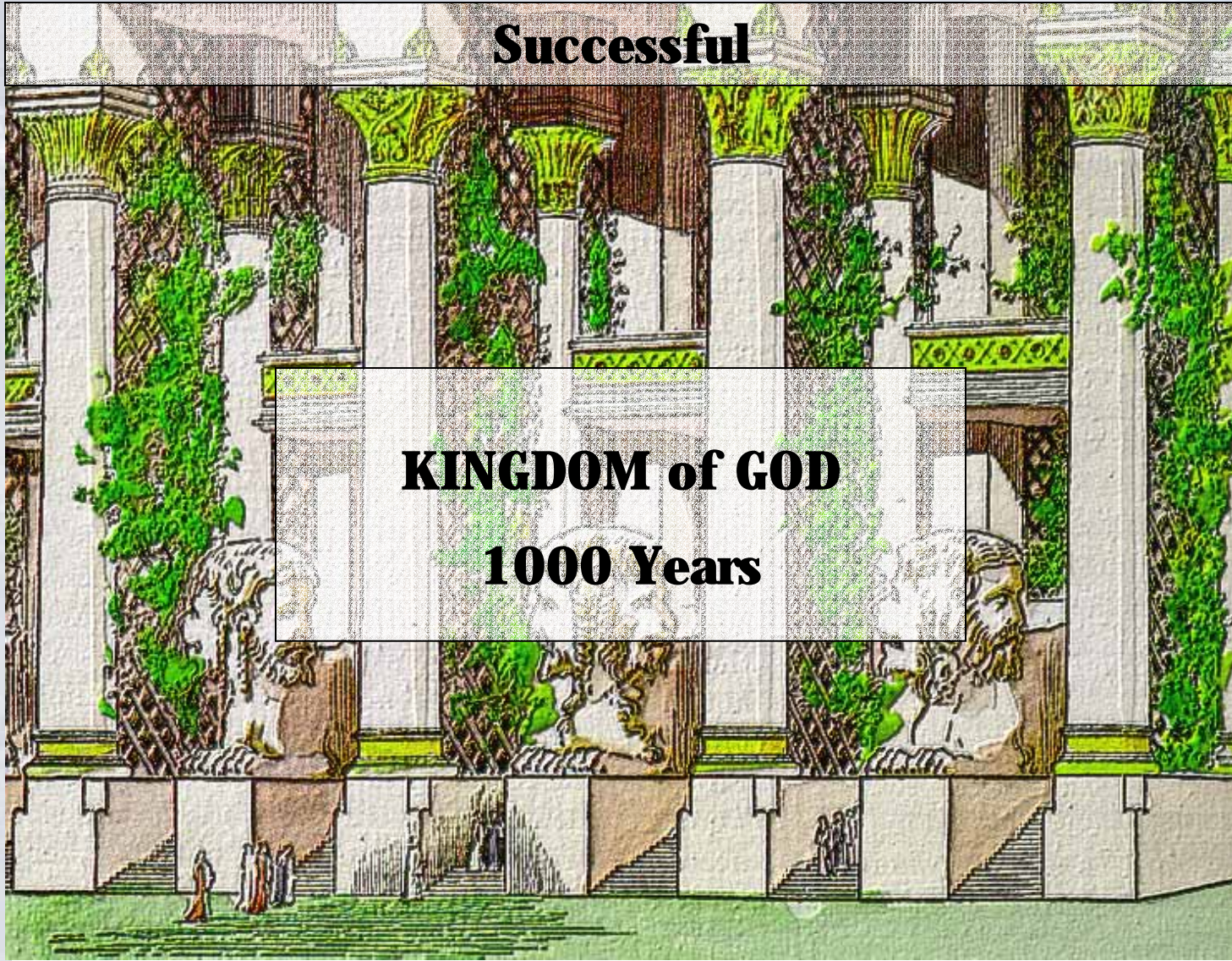

KEY DEVELOPMENTS



IN FALLUJAH: Marines pushing toward the center of the Sunni stronghold draw heavy rifle and grenade fire. A U.S. airstrike hits the outer wall of a mosque compound after gunmen hiding inside launch an attack.

IN CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN IRAQ: Shiite militias tighten their control over Karbala, Kufa and Najaf and seize the city of Kut.

IN NORTHERN IRAQ: The unrest spreads there for the first time as U.S. troops in Hawlajah, near Kirkuk, fire on an angry mob protesting American tactics in Fallujah.

IN BAGHDAD, RIGHT: Armed supporters of Shiite cleric Muqtada al-Sadr chant anti-U.S. slogans Wednesday in the Sadr City neighborhood, the site of bloody clashes earlier in the week.

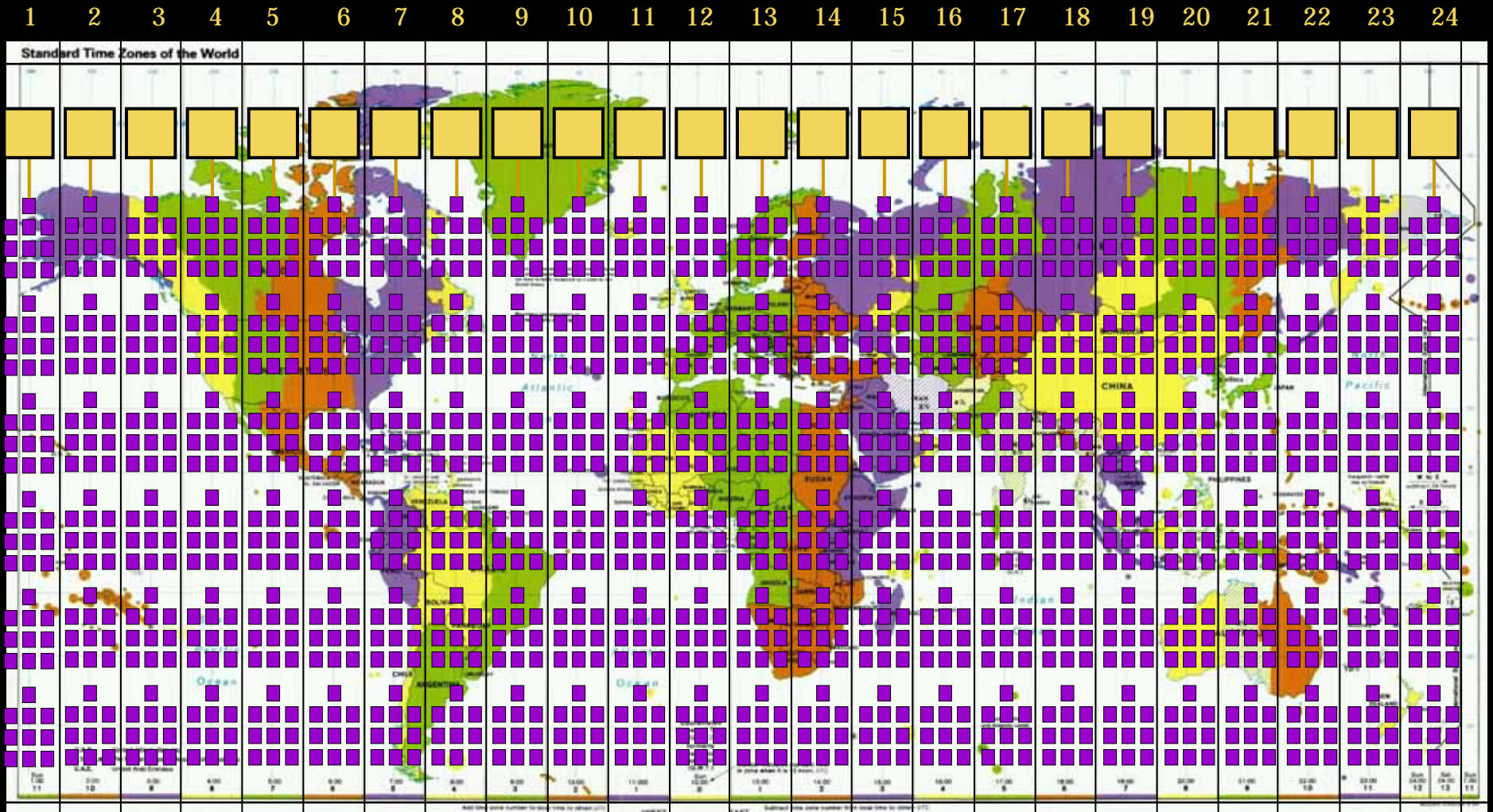

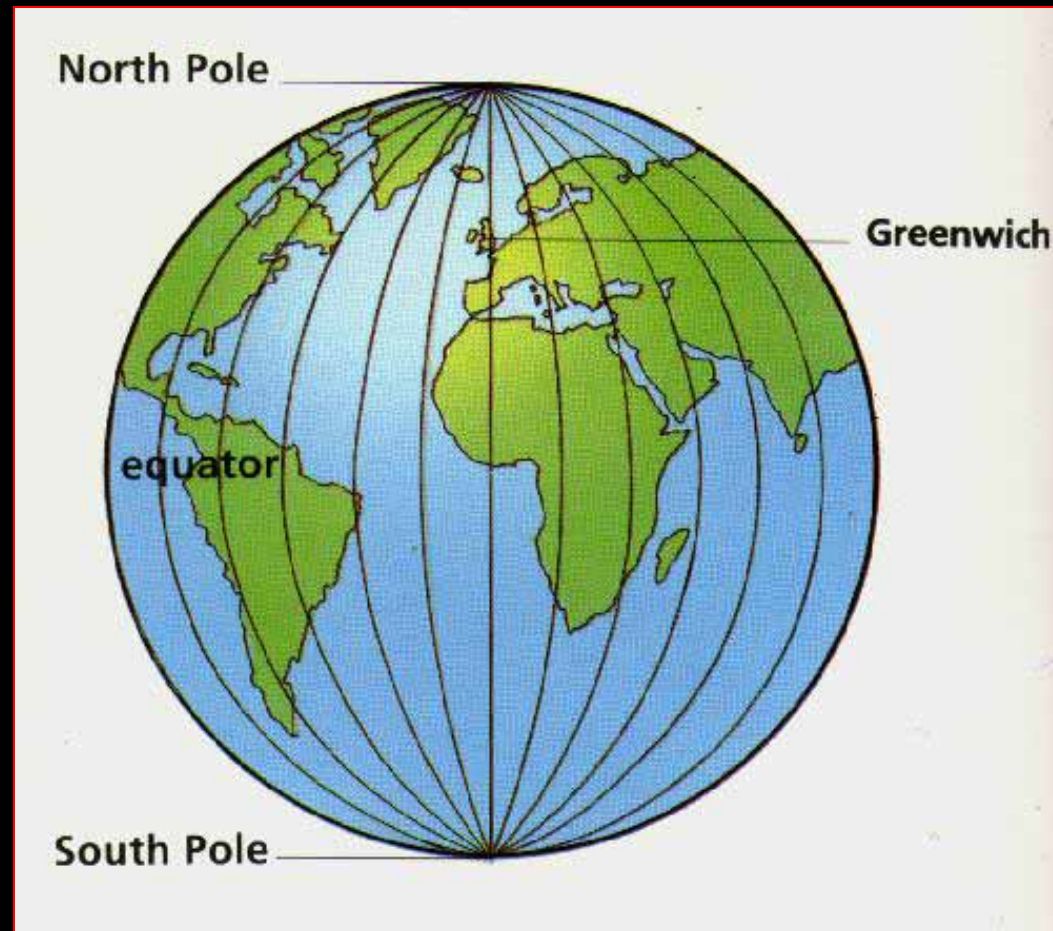
