Why does the child have to die?

- Shame to MY NAME lasting memorial to Sin
- God's righteous prerogative Romans 9:15-23, Job 1:20,21
- LUST SIN DEATH metaphor (James 1:14,15)
- This could not be the son of the promises God is making a difference
- The child does not die FOR David, or in place of David David is forgiven upon his confession (not substitutionary atonement)
