His **MERCY** endureth forever!

Why does the child have to die?

- Shame to **MY NAME** – lasting memorial to Sin
- God's **righteous** prerogative – Romans 9:15-23, Job 1:20,21
- LUST – SIN – DEATH metaphor (James 1:14,15)
- This could not be the son of the promises – God is making a difference
- The child does not die FOR David, or in place of David – David is forgiven upon his confession (not substitutionary atonement)
